6. Presentation of Institutional Reports (1/2 hour each followed by 15 minute discussion)**Okanagan College (David Williams):**

- Science, Technology and Health has new dean, Dr. Halia Valladares who will officially start on July 1
- 5 Full-time and 2 term faculty teach 18 electronics courses and 2 courses for mech eng tech
- Program went through accreditation process with TAC (Technology Accreditation Canada) this year. Expecting site visit in Fall 2023
- Bridge program to UBCO engineering remains popular, but looking to modify it for 2024
- ELEN program hosted 17th annual Western Canada Robocup Jr. competition in February

BCIT (Maurice Le Noble)

- BCIT has new president, Dr Jeff Zabudsky who will officially join BCIT on July 10, 2023
- Electrical Engineering and Technology Department has a new associate Dean, Matthew Pedley who joins from BC Hydro.
- Department has initiated the accreditation process with TAC for all three options within electrical engineering diploma programs. Expected completion 2024
- Program review is underway for electrical Engineering Diploma Program
- The Diploma in Industrial Network Cybersecurity Program, which launched in September 2019 with an initial intake of 17 students, now fills with an intake of 40 students
