6. BCCAT Report

• Spring update: BCCAT celebrating 35th anniversary as the oldest provincial articulation committee. New council chair from Selkirk College. Research projects underway, including admissions through a disability justice lens (undertaken by researchers from KPU). Professional regulation (accreditation) having an impact on transferability of credits. Direct (or proactive) admissions is occurring for some units. Be aware to design course outlines for transferability. CFP for 2024-25 research. 3-year strategic plan includes attention to data exchange between Ontario and BC. Annual meeting in November, will be available hybrid. All sessions will be recorded and available on youtube channel.

8. TOPIC: Query about increased hostility (specifically misogyny and transphobia), do units/staff receive support from administration?

Discussion highlighted that deans support but upper administration offers limited responses, which tend toward safeguarding after the fact rather than thinking preventatively.

9. TOPIC: Changing the name of the committee from Women's Studies to a name that better captures current programs and offerings.
