



2018 BCCAT TRANSFER AWARDS

OVERVIEW

BCCAT is now accepting nominations for the *2018 BCCAT Transfer Awards* from colleagues working at a BC post-secondary institution or system agency operating within the BC Transfer System (see bccat.ca/system/membership/).

Nominators are responsible for:

- a) submitting a completed nomination form,
- b) securing endorsements from two additional colleagues in support of the nomination, and
- c) contacting the nominee (before submitting) to confirm their willingness to stand.

To nominate a colleague or a group, please return the full nomination package by email to awards@bccat.ca by the end of day on **Friday, June 29, 2018**. Please include “BCCAT Transfer Awards” in your subject line.

1. Nominators should indicate clearly the award category under consideration,¹ complete all fields in the nomination form, and ensure that they have understood and agreed to the terms and conditions of the nomination process. NOTE: In order to keep the selection process fair, any additional documentation (references, resumes, etc.) will be disregarded by the adjudication committee.
2. Nominations will be reviewed and adjudicated by a peer representative committee. Members of the committee are selected by BCCAT to represent those serving in a variety of roles to support transfer and articulation (e.g. senior administrators, faculty, transfer credit support staff, and advisors) and to reflect the diversity of the BC Transfer System.

The adjudication committee will forward recommendations to the Council, and the Council will make the final decisions regarding successful candidates. The Awards Ceremony will be held in conjunction with the 2018 Joint Annual Meeting (see bccat.ca/articulation/jam). ¹ For award categories 1-3, at least one award will be granted each year if suitable nominations are submitted. Depending on the number and quality of nominations submitted, it is possible that additional awards may be granted in the same category. The *Lifetime Achievement Award* will only be awarded when exemplary nominations are received.
