- **3.** Chairs Report: Morgan thanked the group for the opportunity to serve as Chair. She also thanked Dave Twynam for serving as the System Liaison Person (SLP).
  - 4. Presentation of Institutional Reports (see attached)
  - 5. Core Learning Outcomes Rob Ferguson: Rob presented the Fourth Edition FINAL DRAFT February 11, 2018 to the committee. The thematic approach was meant to guard autonomy in the institutions and attempt to not be overly prescriptive. This approach will align with the new secondary curriculum.

- 6. BC Transfer Guide/Block Transfer Linkages Out of Date Rob Ferguson: Rob presented the BC transfer guide from bctransfreguide.ca for Tourism Management and noted that it is out of date. Work needs to be done to clean up the online published block transfer iterations for articulated programs on institutional websites. Rob will follow up with BCCAT to update BC transfer guide.
- 7. BCCAT Director, Transfer & Articulation Meg Stainsby: Meg updated the group on current research projects BCCAT is undertaking (see bccat.ca). She emphasized the need for updating transfer agreements. She also updated the group on the

implementation of the new K-12 curriculum. The grade 10/11/12 curriculum will be in place next fall.

8. Follow up on Supporting Tourism 11 and 12: The new themed core outcomes put into motion seem to align with the secondary curriculum. More collaboration is needed to understand who is teaching Tourism 11/12, and who can maintain the contact list. Kellee Canton from TRU and Morgan Westcott from BCIT will investigate BePress, a digital commons for "Introduction to Tourism and Hospitality" resources that can be used by instructors at the secondary level as well as our programs. This will be an editable, accessible shared platform for us to store resources to the benefit of secondary and post-secondary instructors alike. We will continue to explore the ways we can encourage our alumni to teach Tour 11 and 12. This will be a standing agenda item for next year's articulation meeting so we can continue to unpack the issue. Below is the curriculum that will be rolled out in 2019 and if you have a look the need for additional resources becomes apparent.
