The Articulation Guidelines Revision Subcommittee will continue to look at Learning outcomes, goal statements and Indigenous Language and Interdisciplinary Indigenous Course Learning outcomes to be consistent with the Indigenous Fine Arts Learning Outcomes. Interdisciplinary Indigenization of courses will include Indigenous Ways of Knowing developed with Community Traditional Knowledge keepers, and with focus and guidance of Principles of First Peoples Learning.

"*Learners in any First Nations course will be able to*" CHANGE TO: "*Learners in any Indigenous Studies course will be able to:*"
