




Guides/Handbooks

Student Mobility

BC post-secondary students are highly mobile, and BCTransferGuide.ca informs students as they plan their transfer pathways. Below are some key statistics on the BC Transfer System and the BCCAT network:

- 25 BC public colleges, institutes & universities; 14 private and out-of-province institutions
- 65 articulation committees and 1000s of faculty and staff
- Over 400,000 academic course credits are recognized for transfer by BC public institutions each annually
- Over **55,000** students move between BC public post-secondary institutions annually
- The BC Transfer Guide includes over 325,000 provincial, national and international course equivalencies and over 1,400 program pathway agreements.
- 45% of baccalaureate degree grads attend more than one institution
