

Call for Proposals: Pandemic-Related Changes in Post-Secondary: An Overview of Students' Surveys and Institutional Responses

Background

While the full impact of Covid-19 on post-secondary education is yet to be seen, institutions are interested to see how students have adapted to learning during the pandemic. In order to better serve their student population, many PSIs and other stakeholders (e.g., Statistics Canada: https://www150.statcan.gc.ca/n1/en/pub/45-28-0001/2020001/article/00015-eng.pdf or OCUFA: https://ocufa.on.ca/assets/OCUFA-2020-Faculty-Student-Survey-opt.pdf) have conducted surveys on how students are reacting to changing post-secondary environment. This study aims at creating a repository of such surveys in order to summarize key findings, and to provide a resource for institutions designing surveys in the future.

Purpose/ Goal

To create a multi-jurisdictional repository of surveys that assess how students are responding to Covid-19 and to summarize survey findings

Scope

Multi-jurisdictional, with a focus on Canada and BC.

Objectives

The objective(s) of this project are to:

- a) Conduct a multi-jurisdictional literature review on impacts that pandemic has had on students:
- b) Create a repository of surveys documents on the impact of Covid-19 on students and, if available, the aggregated results or reports of these surveys, identifying common themes where possible;
- c) Assess whether/ how the findings of the surveys have been acted upon by the institutions; and
- d) Identify areas for future research.

Timeline

Completion date for this project will be no later than March 2022.

Budget

Maximum budget available for this project is \$20,000. This figure is inclusive of all hourly charges, travel and associated costs, and GST.
