- BC Transfer Guide to include discipline specific guides that haven't been embedded before
- Jen expressed concerns about the impact of losing KPU's Moodle support how do we organise meetings without it, given we transferred everything to Moodle. Will BCCAT help us transfer everything?
- Fiona Moodle is not disappearing. There should be a replacement host by Sept. Goal is to transfer existing content.
- Jen raises questions around micro-credentials and transfer based on JAM event.
