## Spring Articulation Committee Meetings

## Transfer and Articulation

UBC has updated their subject prefixes to now include a “\_V” for subjects offered at the Vancouver campus, and “\_O” for subjects offered at the Okanagan Campus. For example, “UBCV MATH 100” is now “UBCV MATH\_V 100”, and “UBCO BIOL 205” is now “UBCO BIOL\_O 205” etc. UBC course listings have been updated in the BC Transfer Guide to reflect these updates. There are no changes to course equivalencies.
