# **PROGRAM MODULE**

can operate **stand-alone** and features a tool that allows users to assess program completion & progress.

# **PATHWAY MODULE**

allows for a gap analysis of the course-to-course equivalencies between two programs, permitting focused articulation activity to establish equivalency.

Both modules allow for a central **repository of** programs & pathway agreements, accessible by our stakeholders in our transfer system.






# WHY BUILD A **PROGRAM PROFILE?**

Program requirements include **courses** & **non-course** elements based in policy, such as residency & graduation grade requirements.


Pathway module leverages the TCS workflow and the program profiles in the Program module, and both modules leverage the TCS course repository and C2C agreement repository.



# System supported communication & change management

Parties to the pathway agreement receive **automatic notifications** when:

- pathway work starts & progresses to the next stage,
- there are course changes in the TCS and/or program module that impact the pathway agreement, and
- C2C transfer agreements & pathway agreements are reaching their end date

Stage 3: All Party Review



SME or Registrarial staff select a course to review & assess the associated C2C agreements, to **determine applicability** to meet program requirement.
